Call for Papers

The Pedagogical Institute of Vojvodina, the Departments of Hungarian Studies, Romanian Studies, Ruthenian Studies, and Slovak Studies of the Faculty of Philosophy, University of Novi Sad, and the University of Novi Sad Hungarian Language Teacher Training Faculty, Subotica, are pleased to announce the **12th International Scientific Conference “Interculturality in Education – INTERKULT 2026”**, to be held on **October 10th 2026** at the **Petőfi Sándor Hungarian Cultural Centre** in Novi Sad (József Attila 16).

As in previous years, the conference aims to present current research findings and promote interculturality, foster networking among national and international scholars and professionals in the field of intercultural education, and facilitate the exchange of experiences concerning the practical implementation of intercultural competence among all stakeholders in education.

The central theme of the conference, **Interculturality in Education**, encompasses the following thematic areas:

- Interculturality and Teaching;
- Interculturality and Language;
- Interculturality and Literature;
- Interculturality and History;
- Interculturality and Translation;
- Interculturality and the Influence of Media.

Abstract Submission Guidelines

- Participation in the 12th International Scientific Conference *Interculturality in Education – INTERKULT 2026* is based on the submission of abstracts of original scholarly papers that have not been previously published or submitted for publication elsewhere.
- Each author may submit a maximum of one paper. A paper may have no more than two co-authors.
- Prospective participants should submit their abstracts via e-mail to danijela@pzv.org.rs. The deadline for abstract submission is **July 15th 2026**.
- The title of the paper must not exceed **200 characters (including spaces)**.
- Abstracts should not exceed **1,000 characters (including spaces)** and should provide the essential information regarding the research, including the research problem, objectives, methodology, and principal findings. Authors are also required to provide up to **five keywords**.
- Abstracts must be submitted both in **one of the official conference languages** (Serbian, Hungarian, Slovak, Romanian, Ruthenian, or Croatian) and in **English**. If the paper is written in English, the abstract must additionally be provided in Serbian.
- Abstracts will undergo peer review and will be evaluated on the basis of their originality and the scientific contribution of the research presented.
- Notification of acceptance will be sent to applicants no later than **July 30th 2026**.
- Oral presentations are limited to **15 minutes**, followed by **5 minutes** for discussion.

Full Paper Submission

- Manuscripts prepared for publication must be submitted electronically to danijela@pzv.org.rs no later than **December 1st 2026**. Submissions received after this deadline will not be considered.
- Authors should prepare their manuscripts in accordance with the **INTERKULT 2026 Style Sheet**, which may be used as a template for formatting.
- The manuscript length should be between **29,000 and 35,000 characters**, including the abstract, summary, and references.
- The average number of required self-citations (without repetition and from the M20 category) is **two per author**, except in the field of humanities.

Publication Policy

Participation in the conference does not automatically guarantee publication of the submitted paper. Selected manuscripts that successfully complete the peer-review process will be published in the conference proceedings volume.

All submissions will be subject to a **double anonymous peer-review process**, with each manuscript evaluated by **two independent reviewers**.

Conference Fee

No conference fee will be charged.
